## Pen & Ink Boots - Workshop

Whether you are a beginner, or already have some experience, join us for a workshop using pen & ink. You will learn the fundamentals of pen strokes and layering, and capture the character of these old work boots using a traditional cross hatching technique. Photo reference will be provided by the instructor. You are welcome to bring a lunch or use the cafeteria.

## Please bring to class:

**Paper**: 1 or 2 pieces of 8" x 10" Bristol plate (smooth) paper, student quality is fine (one large sheet can be cut into several pieces, or you can purchase a bristol sketch pad)

**Pens**: 2 black, permanent ink pens, sizes .005, .01 suggested (eg: Micron fine point or Staedler) If you have more pens, bring them along

1 graphite pencil (2H, H, or HB) and pencil sharpener

1 white and/or kneadable eraser (for erasing pencil)

1 sand eraser (for erasing ink) – *optional* 

1 soft graphite stick (2B or 3B) OR 1 sheet of grey (graphite) **erasable** transfer paper, approx. 8" x 11"

green painters tape - optional

\$1 photo reference fee payable to the instructor

We will be drawing on tables. If you prefer to draw on a more upright surface, you may bring a drawing board.

Most art stores will give a discount on supplies for an art class, so make sure you take your class receipt with you when shopping. Some art stores in Edmonton include The Gilded Rabbit, Delta Art and Drafting, Colours Art and Framing, and The Paint Spot.
